Cherri Gregg is the afternoon drive host/news anchor and co-host of the daily news show Studio 2 on WHYY radio. She is also the executive producer and host of The Good Souls Project, WHYY's effort to highlight individuals serving as role models for compassion, generosity and service.

Prior to her current position, the award winning journalist covered civil rights, social justice, race and public affairs issues impacting marginalized communities, spending nearly a decade on air at KYW Newsradio. She served as the station's Community Affairs reporter and was the creator, host and executive producer of the weekly, syndicated radio show and podcast, Flashpoint with Cherri Gregg.

Under her leadership, the show earned two regional Edward R. Murrow Awards, a NABJ Salute to Excellence Award for Best Podcast and a Pennsylvania Bar Association Media Award all in 2021. Cherri, who is also a licensed attorney, is also a founding member of the Board of Directors of the Law & Justice Journalism Project, a non-profit focused on shifting the journalism narrative around public safety, crime and justice. Cherri is a past president of the Philadelphia Association of Black Journalists.
